The following action was taken at the March 29, 2016 Land Committee meeting:

The Committee recommended that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission Approval to amend the fifty (50) year intergovernmental agreement for the former Unicoi State Park: Camp Appalachian Wilderness, White County.

The Committee recommended that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission Approval to to enter into a twenty-five (25) year lease agreement to acquire 65± acres from the Georgia Power Company at Paulding Forest Wildlife Management Area, Paulding County.

The Committee recommended that the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner to seek State Properties Commission Approval to subgrant a Civil War Battlefield Land Acquisition Grant from the National Park Service to the Civil War Trust to allow the Civil War Trust to purchase and donate a conservation easement over the 308.46± acres Rocky Face Ridge Tract, Whitefield County.
