The January 28, 2022 meeting of the Coastal Resources Committee was called to order by Dee Yancey, Chairman of the Board of Natural Resources.

Chairman Yancey called on Tim Lowe, Acting Chairman of the Coastal Committee, in the absence of Chair Miki Thomaston. Mr. Lowe called on Kathy Knowlton, Marine Fisheries, to present for final action the proposed amendments to the Rules of Saltwater Fishing Regulations, Chapter 391-2-4.

Ms. Knowlton stated the proposed amendments to the Rules of Saltwater Fishing Regulations will include definitions; seasons, daily creel and possession limits, and minimum and maximum size limits; and possession and landing specifications. She further stated these amendments would allow for landing billfish in Georgia so long as all applicable federal regulations regarding their harvest are adhered to. She added the amendments would be implemented on March 1, 2022.

<u>A motion was made by Ms. Addison, seconded by Mr. Hatfield, and carried unanimously</u> <u>that the Committee recommends the Board approve the proposed amendments to the Rules of</u> <u>the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Saltwater Fishing Regulations, Chapter 391-2-4.</u>
