The June 27, 2023 meeting of the Environmental Protection Committee was called to order by Chairman Dwight Davis.

Chairman Davis called on Ray Lambert, Chairman of the Environmental Protection Committee. Mr. Lambert called on Chuck Mueller, Chief of the Land Protection Branch, to present Proposed Amendments to the Rules for Solid Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-4.

Mr. Mueller stated the proposed amendment would create a requirement to prominently display notices of public hearing prior to issuing a permit for a solid waste disposal facility in a location closest to the primary existing entrance or primary proposed entrance where it can be seen unaided from a public right-of-way. He further stated the change will create an exemption of dimension stone fines and spalls from a solid waste handling permit if managed as a recovered material in accordance with the amended Rule and provide for a Permit-by-Rule in those cases where dimension stone fines and spalls are not, or cannot be, re-used or recycled. He added the proposed rules will add new definitions for Dimension Stone Fines, Dimension Stone Spalls, and Radioactive Waste and make minor revisions to other definitions.

Mr. Mueller stated after briefing the Environmental Committee at the March 2023 meeting, there was a comment period ending on May 5 and a public hearing on April 26. He further stated two written comments were received in support of the proposed changes.

Mr. Mueller requested a favorable consideration.

A motion was made by Mr. Yancey, seconded by Mrs. Addison, and carried unanimously that the Committee recommend the Board adopt the Proposed Amendments to the Rules for Solid Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-4. (Resolution attached hereto and made a part thereof)
