The April 26, 2022 meeting of the Land Committee was called to order by Bill Jones, Chairman of the Board of Natural Resources.

Chairman Jones called on Mr. Tim Lowe, Chairman of the Land Committee.

Mr. Lowe called on Steve Friedman, Chief of Real Estate.

Mr. Friedman stated that Item A is seeking approval to enter into a twenty-five (25) year agreement with Augusta-Richmond County for the 2.53± acres Lock and Dam Road Boat Ramp. He further stated the Department will renew the lease on the Savannah River at no cost for a twenty-five (25) year term, and Augusta-Richmond County will assist with general maintenance at no cost to the Department. He added the Wildlife Resources Division (WRD) will continue to operate the boat ramp and parking area while performing structural maintenance and repairs as needed during the life of the lease.

Mr. Friedman stated for the benefit of the public and upon approval by the Board, the Department will enter into a twenty-five (25) year lease agreement with the County at no cost.

<u>A motion was made by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Denney, and carried unanimously that</u> <u>the Committee recommends the Board adopt the Resolution to authorize the Commissioner to</u> <u>seek State Properties Commission approval to enter into a 25-year lease agreement with</u> <u>Augusta-Richmond County for the 2.53+ acres Lock and Dam Boat Ramp.</u>

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
